Bursary

Purpose

The purpose of this bursary is to reward students who demonstrate financial need and who are committed to being engaged citizens **within the Vanier community**.

Value

\$3,000 – Four (4) bursaries valued at \$750 each

Deadline

February 15, 2016

Programs

ALL

Eligibility

1. Be a current full-time day DEC Vanier student who will be returning to Vanier as a full-time or fin-de-DEC student for the Fall 2016 semester.
2. Be in good academic standing, with a minimum R-score of 21.
3. Demonstrate financial need.
4. Commit to volunteering for a minimum of 50 hours during the Fall 2016 semester at Vanier College.

Application requirements

1. A 750-1,000 word essay answering the following: "How will this bursary help you to continue your studies at Vanier College and how do you envision benefitting from the volunteer opportunities that will be available to you?"
2. Demonstrate financial need as exhibited through an application for government financial aid*.
3. Complete an interview with the selection committee if deemed necessary.

Applications must be submitted to Student Services – C203 by 4:00pm on February 15, 2016. Applicants must request that a copy of their transcripts be attached to the application at the time of submission.

* Students must submit an application for government financial aid. Students who are ineligible for financial aid ex: international students or students who have reached eligibility limits, may still be considered for the Liberio Community Involvement Bursary, although additional documentation may be required.
